The palace also houses World War II Air Raid Shelters, providing a dramatic and exciting addition to the house tours.

Private Tour Of St. John's Co-Cathedral, Valletta



St. John's Co-Cathedral stands as a testament to the exquisite blend of Baroque art and architecture. Housing two masterpieces by Caravaggio, this cathedral was originally commissioned by Grand Master Jean de la Cassière in 1572 to serve as the conventual church for the Knights of St John. Designed by the accomplished Maltese military architect Gerolamo Cassar, the church is dedicated to St John the Baptist, the revered patron saint of the Order.

Beyond its historical significance, St John's Co-Cathedral remains a vital shrine and sacred place of worship to this day. The oratory within the cathedral proudly displays the largest and only signed masterpiece by Caravaggio.

Administered by the St John's Co-Cathedral Foundation, this institution is entrusted with the responsibility of preserving the religious and cultural heritage of this remarkable monument.
